#### Family Support Team Help to Improve Lives

The Family Support team do just that - they have helped 144 families build their skills and resilience and helped to improve lives. The team's skills are extremely diverse. Some of the issues tackled have included children's behaviour techniques, self-confidence and debt concerns alongside school attendance, communication and self-expression. Increased well-being and outlook on life, team work for families, listening, calmer homes, practical skills for dealing with problems and decision making skills.

After being home schooled by mum due to marriage breakdown and homelessness. With the support of our dedicated family worker mum was able to enrol her daughters into school for a September start.

## Local young people and families supported by Portsmouth & Southsea car boot sales



In October, a cheque for £3,000 was presented at the site of the summer car boot sales at Southsea Common by Councillor Steve Pitt, Cabinet Member for Culture, Leisure & Sport and Suzy Horton, Cabinet Member for Education. This amazing donation, raised through fees, will be used to continue our essential informal youth work education with young people in the Hot Walls area of Old Portsmouth during the summer months. This year Motiv8 support workers delivered support to over 300 children and young people in the area through our outreach project. This funding will support this work in 2019.

## Why is one to one work so important?

We have supported 159 young people with specialist one to one support since April 2018.

Young people are amazing, however sometimes their situation (struggling in school, anxiety, bullying, abuse, violence at home) means they can't always see the positives in themselves. It's through positive healthy relationships that we know how to be kind, what impact our choices have on others, how we can have trust and understand that not everyone's out to hurt us. We really work hard to build these relationships through our one to one work at Motiv8. Twenty years is just the start and in this difficult climate we're determined to make life chances for young people a priority.

The young people we are supporting feel safe, listened to and understood. Together we stabilise their lives,

raise aspirations, develop resilience and guide them further with, life-chances like skills for work, enabling them to live, learn and earn.

#### A young person's story

I was struggling both at home and in school. My attendance at school was 10% and I was becoming violent and aggressive.

Things at home were bad. My family argued all the time and I would often be left to fend for myself. I realise now I was dealing with a range of emotions with no

one to speak to, that is, until I started to get involved with Motiv8.

I attended special lessons at Motiv8's in the Alternative Education Programme and then I started one to one support. I regularly met with a dedicated Motiv8 Support Worker who helped me build my confidence and self-esteem.

I got involved in other Motiv8 community activities. I liked having something positive to do and I felt Motiv8 was my "safe place". With Motiv8's support I have now gained meaningful employment.



STEPS is Motiv8's personal and social development programme delivered to support schools and colleges. These groups engage hard to reach vulnerable young people who maybe struggling in their current school or college. Motiv8 supports learners to gain confidence in their own abilities and learning and use flexible learning tools to ensure they receive useful qualifications for their futures. Programmes are flexible and can last from six weeks to a year.



## have been up to . . .

WEEK ONE Everyone has such a great time developing their communication and teamwork skills this week. This is followed by a trip to Southsea for volleyball.

WEEK TWO We explore anti-social behaviour (ASB), looking at why young people become involved in crime, who is responsible and who is affected by ASB.

WEEK THREE Our young people focus on communication and teamwork skills this week. A game of number tap is a great way to build on these skills. (see photo below left)

WEEK FOUR Today we continue building on team work skills with the addition of thinking about budgeting by shopping for and making lunch. Seriously delicious!

WEEK FIVE The group give it their all on the Fort Purbrook assault course. Great confidence building!

WEEK SIX Today saw our young people demonstrate their awesome communication skills with the minefield game. Great group work exercise. We're also talking relationships, sex & the law, and consent as part of Sexual Health Week.

Before getting support from Motiv8 I was feeling so low, things were awful at home and I had no support, once I got to know my support worker I felt like I had a good friend, it was the best thing that happened in my life, it has been amazing to have someone who is there for me, who encouraged me to be confident and to return to school.
