## WE DID IT!

We are delighted to announce we have been awarded the Investors in People Platinum accreditation!

Platinum is the highest level of accreditation possible and with a score well above both IIP accredited organisations and those in our sector, achieving platinum places us in the top 5% nationally! That's up from 28% at the last assessment and number 6 in our sector industry group 'Social Work Activities with between 50 - 249 employees'.

Motiv8 are one of just two charities in the country to achieve this Platinum Accreditation.

Policies and practices around supporting people are embedded in every corner of Motiv8, it's something we're hugely passionate about. And in a platinum company, everyone – from the CEO to a Student Support Worker – knows they have a part to play in the company doing well, and is always looking for ways to improve.

Motiv8 has faced several challenges throughout the last year, with the level of needs of the young people Motiv8 supports going up by 48% and lack of funding that enables us to carry out the quality of services for which it is renowned. Despite this, we continue to work hard and provide a safe, warm and welcoming space for vulnerable young people, as well as supporting their families.

A big thanks to Aztec Group who very kindly donated a delicious lunch for the dau!
















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
