Cooking up change!

Something exciting has happened at our new Havant Hub - with the support of our amazing corporate partner Comserv, the kitchen has undergone a complete transformation.

A team of staff from Motiv8 and Comserv - including Kirsty (Motiv8 Chief Executive), Joe (Head of Fundraising and Marketing at Motiv8), Richard (Comserv Group Executive Manager), Julie (Communication and Engagement Manager at Comserv), and other dedicated team members, came together for a day of painting, teamwork and shared purpose. The café and kitchen space at our Havant Hub is now freshly coated in a vibrant blue, giving the area a bright, welcoming feel and a renewed sense of energy.

It's amazing what a splash of colour and collaboration can do to transform a space for the young people we support.



Earlier this year, Motiv8 made a long-term commitment to a left-behind community by taking on a 10-year lease for a building in Leigh Park. This gave us the opportunity to invest in the local area and create lasting change for the young people who need it most.

Thanks to the generous support of our corporate partner Comserv, what was once an empty, basic café and kitchen space has been completely transformed into a fully functional, welcoming environment. Within this new space, we now have the facilities to provide warm meals — meeting the immediate hunger needs of young people in our community.

But it's more than just a cooking space. It's a place to learn, grow, and connect. The kitchen will double as a teaching space, where we can educate young people and families who may not have access to these resources elsewhere. Through hands-on cooking sessions, we can help them build confidence, learn essential life skills and gain knowledge that will stay with them for life and can be shared with others at home.

The transformation also allows us to host larger groups, run more frequent workshops, and offer a space that truly feels safe and supportive. Refurbishing existing rooms has made them more accessible and better equipped to support young people's emotional wellbeing and mental health.

The space is now designed to meet a wide range of needs, offering practical support and a sense of belonging.

Scaling New Heights For Young People

This October, a team of Motiv8 staff, parents corporate partners and supporters Scaled News Heights for Young People' by abseiling down Portsmouth's iconic Spinnaker Tower!

Their mission? To make this descent count and raise much-needed funds for young people across Gosport, Havant, Portsmouth and Fareham (and maybe conquer a fear of heights along the way too!).

Standing at 170 metres tall, the Spinnaker Tower offers breathtaking views - and a 100m adrenaline-pumping descent! Our brave participants were harnessed up and stepped over the edge to make a real difference in the lives of those who need it most. Overall, they raised over £10,000 to help give local young people a brighter future!

Motiv8 staff- and even a young person from the organisation - were among those who took part. Thanks to their efforts, £1,250 of the funds raised will go directly to the Motiv8 Youth Fund: a dedicated resource designed to empower young people.

Any young person can apply to the fund, with support from youth workers and approval from trustees and youth advisors. It can be used to access equipment or opportunities that might otherwise be out of reach. In the past, the fund has helped provide cameras for aspiring photographers, musical instruments for emerging talents, and tickets to events that celebrate programme milestones.
